Instructions for Applying to IPFW

- ✓ Type or print clearly in ink.
- ✓ Use your full, legal name.
- ✓ Return your completed application to IPFW Admissions if you are a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, refugee, or asylee. **Missing or incorrect information will delay consideration of your application.**
- ✓ If you are not a U.S. citizen, call office of International Education at 260-481-6034 about required forms.
- ✓ If you have been academically dismissed from any IU or Purdue campus, contact IPFW Admissions immediately for readmission instructions and deadlines.
- ✓ Check the appropriate admission status below and enclose the additional documents required by the checked status.
- ✓ You may apply online at ipfw.edu/admissions.

No Previous College Work

- Beginning Freshman:** If you have never attended a college, submit this application, an official high school transcript or GED scores, and a \$50 application fee¹. If you graduated from high school less than two years ago, you must also submit SAT or ACT scores.
- Special High School²:** If you are a high school junior or senior ranking in the top half of your class, you may take up to 24 credits as a temporary student. Submit this application and an official high school transcript. SAT or ACT scores may be requested. No application fee is due. Not eligible for financial aid.
- Temporary Student²:** If you graduated from high school more than two years ago and have not attended college, you may take up to 24 credits at IPFW as a special **nondegree-seeking adult student**. Submit this application. No application fee or additional documentation are due. Not eligible for financial aid.

Some Previous College Work

- Temporary Intercampus Transfer from IU or Purdue²:** If you are currently attending, or have attended, another IU or Purdue campus, and want to transfer temporarily to IPFW, submit this application and official transcripts from any colleges attended since your enrollment at IU or Purdue. No application fee is due. Not eligible for financial aid.
- Permanent Intercampus Transfer from IU or Purdue:** If you are currently attending, or have attended, another IU or Purdue campus, and want to transfer permanently to IPFW, submit this application and official transcripts from any colleges attended since your enrollment at IU or Purdue. No application fee is due.
- Reentry:** If you previously attended IPFW as a regularly admitted student, submit this application and official transcripts from any colleges attended since your enrollment at IPFW. No application fee is due.
- Transfer:** If you have attended college but never attended IPFW, IU, or Purdue, and want to transfer to IPFW as a degree-seeking student, submit this application, an official high school transcript or GED scores, a \$50 application fee¹, and official transcripts from all colleges you have attended. If you hold a bachelor's degree, you do not need to submit a high school transcript.
- Bachelor's Degree Holder²:** If you hold a bachelor's degree, you may take up to 24 undergraduate credits as a temporary student. Submit this application. No application fee or transcript is required. Not eligible for financial aid.
- Guest²:** If you want to become a visiting student from another college outside the IU or Purdue system, you may enroll temporarily at IPFW for up to 24 credits. Submit this application and an official transcript from your home institution. You need not submit an application fee. Not eligible for financial aid.

Why We Want To Know

Although your Social Security number (SSN) will not be used as your IPFW student identification number, it is required to receive certain federal tax benefits, and voluntarily requested to apply for financial aid and to accurately match your application with other records such as SAT or ACT scores or transcripts. Disclosure of your SSN will be restricted to university business processes, such as those required for federal and state reporting as well as institutional purposes. By providing your SSN, you authorize the university to disclose it to third parties as necessary for these purposes.

¹ If you are applying or have applied to any other IU or Purdue campus, only one application fee is required. This is a nonrefundable fee. If you have paid the fee at an IU or Purdue campus other than IPFW, please state this in responding to Question 15 on the application.

² Institutional, state, and federal financial aid is not available to temporary students, special college graduates, special high school students, and guests. These are temporary/nondegree-seeking classifications. If you expect to need financial aid, discuss your options with an admissions counselor.

Choosing your major

If you have questions about choosing a major or other decisions about attending college, it's best to make an appointment to talk with an admissions counselor.

Most IPFW academic units or schools have a category for undecided students, and you should consider using it if your interests fall clearly within one academic unit. If your interests are divided between two academic units, you may choose the undecided category in one of them and discuss your alternative interest when meeting with the unit's academic advisor. Or, if you are completely undecided about a major, you may circle the "Undeclared" category under the Mastodon Advising Center (MAC).
